PROPOSALS FOR THE AGM TO ALLOW A DECISION BY GENERAL CONSENSUS (OR VOTE) ON THE NIGHT OF AGM:

1.0 DONEGAL LEAQUE (PC CARR CUP)

Introduce a new rule for the Donegal Interclub Fourball Matchplay:

'The maximum number of shots which can be conceded in the first match is capped at 4.'

REASON: To uphold the established tradition of the clubs' fielding their lower handicap players in the no. 1 match.

2.0 ADVICE

All competitions to reference clause 6.6 of General Regulations for Golf Ireland Team Competitions regarding 'Advice'.

6.6 ADVICE

(a)	Each team may name one advice giver whom players on the team may ask for advice and receive advice from during the round. The team must identify each advice giver to the Committee before any player on the team begins his or her round. NOTE – In the case of Inter-Club matches where a number of matches are taking place simultaneously at two venues (e.g. three at home and two away or vice-versa), teams may appoint an advice-giver at each venue. (Rule 24.4)
(b)	The team may change its advice-giver during a round, but must tell the Official in Charge when doing so. For matches where an official is not present, the team must inform their opposing Team Captain or person in charge before doing so.
(c)	The advice giver must not point out a line of play on the Green or walk on the Green when the ball of a team player lies on the putting green.
(d)	In Team events where the age limit is under 18 or below, Professional golfers are not permitted to be advice givers.
(e)	Penalty for breach of Regulation – The player gets the General Penalty for each hole during which he or she is helped by an advice giver/non-sanctioned individual contrary to the provisions of this Regulation. If the breach happens or continues between two holes, the player gets the General Penalty for the next hole.

REASON: To clarify the rule on advice being given during matches in response to a query being directed toward towards the committee in one of last year's matches.

3.0 CLUB REPRESENTATION ON THE COMMITTEE

The committee invite and encourage clubs to nominate a representative from their club (if not already represented) to join the Committee.

REASON: To strengthen the Committee's mission statement of promoting Golf in Donegal for the members of Donegal Clubs and Strabane.
